PCP Orders

PCP orders are needed for all OT services. However, PCP orders for PT are not required except in the case of fractures, post-operative care, soft tissue or tendon tears, neurological conditions such as balance disorders and pelvic floor conditions. You may request a PCP order for PT/OT by calling your clinic or sending a message right to your PCP through GHCMYChartSM.
